

**Crosby Capriol SS Peter & Paul's Concert**  
**Covid-safety Saturday, 26<sup>th</sup> March 2022**

Crosby Capriol will be following the government advice, as it applies to England and that of Health England

**Entry requirements**

Capriol Singers believe **you should not attend if:**

- You have any symptoms of Covid-19
- You have tested positive for Covid-19 in the 10 days prior to attending the event.
- You are required to self-isolate, or quarantine under government guidance.

We encourage everyone attending to make use of the self-administered Rapid Lateral Flow Test. We will not, however, ask for evidence of negative test results, nor evidence of vaccination before entering the concert venue.

**Tickets**

- Tickets are being sold on-line to minimise the need for physical tickets and the exchange of cash.
- Tickets will be available at the door. The cost will be £10 to reduce the need to handle loose change.

**Ventilation**

- The church interior covers a large area and the building is also tall so that there is good ventilation.
- The concert takes place in March and it is necessary to balance the need for ventilation/fresh air with maintaining an adequate temperature. The side entrance door to the church and rear door can all be opened. The doors will be closed to begin with but can be opened and shut, as necessary, should the need for fresh air arise.

**Face Coverings**

- The government no longer requires people to wear face masks at indoor venues. However, Capriol recommends and asks that our audience members continue to wear a face mask to protect themselves and others.

**Social Distancing**

- There is sufficient space in the church to accommodate a number significantly greater than the expected audience number.
- The venue is large and spacious. There is adequate spare seating within the venue to permit those audience members who wish to sit away from others to do so. If any members of the audience would like to maintain social distance, please do so by placing an object on the seat next to you to separate yourself from other members of the audience.
- To reduce the risk of spreading the virus via contaminated surfaces, we regret that **there will be no paper programmes for this concert**. An "e-programme" is available on both Capriol website and Capriol Facebook pages.
- The estimated **duration** of the event is approx. 1hr 45 mins.
- It is judged that singers and accompanist will require **a short break**/interval. We would, however, ask that where possible people **limit their walking around the church** to minimise risk.

- There will be **no refreshments** served to minimise movement and interaction.
- Whilst the **raffle** is normally an addition and significant fund raiser for Capriol, to reduce movement & the risk of contamination, there will not be a raffle at this concert.

#### **Sanitising**

- To reduce risk Hand Sanitizer will be placed at the entrance point. A pack of antivac wipes will be placed in the toilet.

#### **Toilet**

- There are limited toilet facilities. If using the toilet, please understand that you may have to wait and maintain an appropriate distance from others queuing.

#### **Performers**

- Singers will be in the sanctuary area. Singers will be separated by a similar distance to that used in rehearsals.
- Julie Oade, our accompanist will be using a piano and will be placed away from the singers.
